






BRAZIL

The **Rav Berg Zohar Project** continued its mission as a global force of transformation, sharing over **730,000 Zohars**—nearly quadrupling the reach of just two years ago.


- **Florida:** Zohars distributed in hurricane-prone regions as part of a spiritual protection belt.
- **Philippines:** Shared with members of the Philippines Coast Guard on the frontlines of service.
- **Israel:** Thousands of Zohars placed in hospitals, schools, supermarkets, and security sectors.
- **Brazil:** 1,500 Zohars delivered to flood-ravaged farmland, reaching individuals, universities, and hospitals.
- **Wave of Love Campaign:** Brought Light to communities affected by hate crimes in **California, Florida, Las Vegas, and Mexico**.

In the wake of the devastating conflicts in the Middle East, our global community turned to the most powerful spiritual tool we know—the Zohar. Rooted in centuries of Kabbalistic wisdom, the Zohar offers the Light needed to transform pain, suffering, and chaos into healing, purpose, and peace. From simply possessing a Zohar to actively studying and sharing its teachings, each interaction with this sacred text reveals Light and deepens our collective spiritual connection.

In March 2024, Michael and Monica Berg led a Global Meditation for Peace from the resting place of Rav and Karen Berg in Israel—a site charged with their enduring energy and commitment to peace. As violence continues to affect innocent lives, this moment of collective prayer reminded us of our power to bring healing through unity, intention, and spiritual action.

From that inspiration emerged the [One Million Zohar Campaign](#), a bold initiative to distribute one million Pinchas pocket Zohars across the globe.



THE KAREN BERG SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Spiritual wisdom should never be limited by financial barriers. The Karen Berg Scholarship Fund (KBSF) was established to honor that belief, making it possible for students around the world to access life-changing teachings regardless of their finances.

In 2024 alone, the Scholarship Fund helped sponsor **382** courses and events, welcoming a total of **56,683 recipients** impacted by some level of financial assistance—of which 2,692 were full scholarship recipients.



A SPIRITUAL LENS ON RECOVERY

Launched in Summer 2024, [Empowerment Through Kabbalah](#) is a groundbreaking new program offering spiritual support for those navigating addiction recovery. Merging the deep wisdom of Kabbalah with tools from Alcoholics Anonymous and other recovery modalities, this program helps participants cultivate lasting connections—with themselves, with others, and with a Higher Power.

With guided journaling workbooks, meditations, mindfulness practices, and mentorship from Kabbalah students in recovery, the program fosters a supportive, nonjudgmental space for growth. What began as two 10-week courses has now expanded to include ongoing bi-weekly Q&A sessions.

Over 250 students have already participated, many sharing that it not only supports their sobriety but also strengthens their spiritual path—no matter their background or belief system.

One student shared, “I am more involved in life and in living. The course has also shown me that I am not alone. I have been able to connect to my deepest desires once again. I feel a desire to share truly.”







TRANSFORMING LIVES AROUND THE WORLD

Through meaningful initiatives and partnerships, our global Kabbalah Centres continue to bring Light to underserved communities—offering not only physical support, but spiritual tools to inspire long-lasting transformation.

MEXICO: CREATIVITY, CONNECTION & COMMUNITY

As part of the [Kabbalah to the Community](#) program, our team in Mexico launched Transformarte (Transform Yourself) in February 2024. Designed to help participants discover their inner essence—the unique “superpower” each person carries—the project was brought to La Comuna, a community center in Iztapalapa, one of Mexico City’s most dangerous areas including the highest rate of juvenile delinquency.

Over four sessions, children, parents, and even grandparents joined together in meditation and art activities. In the final session, participants co-wrote an original song, *A Thousand Dinosaurs*, exploring themes of love, joy, friendship, and strength. The song became the inspiration for a beautiful 7-meter mural, painted by over 40 Kabbalah Centre volunteers between September and October 2024.

The mural was inspired by the children's drawings and tells how through empathy and friendship we can overcome our challenges, transforming them into happiness to share with the world. As the song says: "Fill myself with hope with the strength of the colors of a thousand dinosaurs."



PHILIPPINES: SPREADING LIGHT TO SAMPALOC, MANILA

In Sampaloc—one of Manila's most densely populated and underserved communities, with a high concentration of informal settlers and limited access to basic services—students carried out a powerful outreach initiative combining practical aid and spiritual empowerment.

With the help of local volunteers, 50 families received food, Zohars, and information about the power of Kabbalah to protect and transform lives.

Charity: Water

On Purim, we are reminded that even the smallest act of giving can unlock protection and blessings for the entire year. During Purim we partnered with charity: water to help provide clean drinking water to rural communities around the world.

Centres in Mexico launched the **Volunteer Building Project** —a three-tiered initiative aligned with the completion of Kabbalah 1, 2, and 3 courses. This progressive program nurtures a deeper connection to service through hands-on experience:

Acts of Kindness in Action

Recent Kabbalah 1 graduates teamed up with local NGOs to collaborate on tasks, such as painting “peace classrooms” (designated spaces for meditation), preparing meals for hospital caregivers, and supporting individuals in vulnerable conditions.

Together, we are building not only a stronger Centre—but a more spiritually awakened world.

CFO STATEMENT

Dear Students, Community Members & Supporters,

We are proud to report 2024 marked yet another profitable year for The Kabbalah Centre in the US, closing the year with a modest surplus of \$857K before depreciation. Having maintained profitability for five years in a row, we are also happy to share that the Centre's assets & holdings are at an all-time high, providing a solid foundation for the Centre's stability and growth as we look ahead. We were able to achieve these results amidst extraordinary legal expenses, revenue and donations being down - a trend seen in non-profits worldwide - and expenses increasing, as we continue our planned investments in technology and marketing to achieve our goal of reaching more and more new students with these life-changing teachings. We were able to hold true to our growth-driving investments in the midst of high economic volatility, with uncertainty related to tariffs, the continued impacts of inflation, and war waging in the Middle East, to continue in our pursuit of the Centre's mission with the world continually in need of the Kabbalistic wisdom and tools.

Our key funds continue to grow with increased support year-over-year, with 2024 seeing:

- The Karen Berg Scholarship Fund offering over 50,000 participants free or pay-what-you-can subsidized courses and events.
- A record-setting 730,000 Zohars distributed globally through The Rav Berg Zohar Project Fund toward our 1 Million Zohar Project campaign goal, begun in the wake of 2023's devastating conflicts in the Middle East

- An expansion of the ROOTS youth program, including The Tale of the Other Glove launch, hosting in-person retreats & Shabbats, launching a morning connection video series for kids and a five-part video series for parents, opening Teen & Pre-Teen Kabbalah 1's around the world, and continually offering scholarships for Youth and Conscious Parenting Guidance Sessions.
- Expanding the efforts for our teachers to support to our student communities all around the world, including the relocation of many Chevre to new Centres, US Student Support teachers visiting our many study groups around the country, the opening of the Design District Spiritually Hungry location in Miami, FL with the Viners, and Batsheva Meron relocating to Argentina which hasn't had a teacher's in-person presence in many years.
- Times of Elevation, Vol. 1 was published and launched globally online and in local bookstores, supporting students in their Zohar studies tied to holidays and notable hilulahs.
- We continue to see year-over-year growth, nearly doubled the number of new students compared to 2022 by welcoming over 60,000 individuals, including through the launch of Monica Berg's first master class, Rethink It: Love.

Throughout 2024 and 2205, the finance team worked diligently to reinforce the Centre's relationships with our business partners, auditors, bankers and lenders, while furthering the Center's overall mission and impact. Through the finance, leadership, and management teams' steadfast hard work, determination, and great care throughout 2024, The Kabbalah Centre continues to build upon its incredible financial transformation that began in 2019, allowing us to continue to operate with financial stability.

ACCOUNTABILITY

For the seventh consecutive year since 2018, the independent audit firm, SAX LLP, was engaged to conduct a thorough review of the Centre's financial statements to uphold our commitment to you of fostering a culture of transparency, accountability, and stewardship for the financial support and donations you entrust us with. It is with great privilege that we hereby report the independent outside audit firm issued a clean opinion of the Centre's financial statements for the year ending December 31, 2024, securing our seventh consecutive clean opinion since pursuing external audits.

STEWARDSHIP

We've continued in our concerted internal efforts over the past year to continually improve our stewardship of resources. From our 2017 peak of \$60 million, our expenses were reduced to \$33.1M as of Dec. 31, 2024. We continue to balance our approach to reducing expenses with aggressive investments in our technology, infrastructure, & programming toward achieving our growth goals.

STABILITY & GROWTH

2024 set the stage for a strong 2025 as we continue to maximize, protect, and safeguard the Centre's assets while continuing on our growth path by investing in our talent and technological infrastructure. As stated in 2021, 2024 marked our third and final year of a planned three-year capital investment into our overarching technological infrastructure. In 2024, this investment encompassed:

- The launch of enhanced features within the Zohar app, including push notifications for daily spiritual reminders, uninterrupted audio, and a new search function to easily find specific sections, for a smoother, more immersive journey through the sacred text.
- New features and functionality within Kabbalah.com, including an upgraded search, introduction of course portals, ADA compliance accessibility, launch of the new Onehouse Membership on-demand only tier, and new logged-out homepage design.
- IT upgrades throughout the organization, including a new Wi-Fi system in all US Centres, an employee self-service portal and help desk, transition to Vimeo for all livestreams, AI features within our internal video archive, and the first phase of new security cameras in KCNY.
- Updates made to our products and services platforms, including an updated US online bookstore both front and backends, and a student order portal added to the Guidance Services site.

- Investing in Michael & Monica's social media presence, including the hiring of a social media strategist and a social media video editor, to expand the reach of inspiring content across Instagram, TikTok, and Facebook.

Amidst all of these concerted positive efforts, there are still obstacles and challenges facing the financial health of The Kabbalah Centre. As a non-profit organization dedicated to altruistic goals of spreading spiritual teachings and, through them, improving our students' lives, we endeavor to make the teachings and services we offer as affordable as possible for anyone to be able to access them. In addition, much like higher educational institutions, we rely on a robust cast of talented teachers and Chevre and their dedication, passion, and knowledge to disseminate this wisdom and nurture the spiritual journeys of our students. This large, global staff base carries an associated cost, one in which we are committed to continuing to invest in by offering competitive wages and benefit packages. As of this letter dated August 2025, we continue to make progress toward our growth goals and have solidified our financial stability in the fiscal year thus far. We're optimistic in continuing on this trajectory as we look ahead to the remainder of the current year. Just in the first half of 2025, we've already accomplished:

- Successful publishing launches of Times of Elevation Vol. 2 and Gate of Reincarnations Vol. 1 & 2
- A relaunch of the Supporters of the Work program, generating 400 new supporters thus far to help sustain our efforts every month

- Reaching the unprecedented milestone of spreading 1,000,000 Zohars to achieve our 1 Million Zohar Project goal
- The launch of Michael Berg's new monthly deep study Revelations of Light: Kabbalistic Secrets from the Ari on the Ari's hilulah
- Supporting virtual students with a deeper and more immersive learning experience with the launch of the new Limitless course with Eitan Yardeni, levels 1 & 2
- Expanding the Empowerment Through Kabbalah: A Spiritual Lens on Recovery course by opening level 2 and hosting another sold-out round of level 1
- Updating the Kabbalah.com live stream video player, including offering new Shabbat continuous streams
- Supporting the LA Wildfire response with over 2,200 Pinchas Zohars distributed, along with supplies and resources to firefighters and the local community, as well as donating the use of the LA KCA School location to a school from Palace Verdes for free for 6 months
- Introducing new Onehouse Membership curated weekly study recommendations for new and advanced students via WhatsApp communities, offering real time support for students to get the most out of their membership

As we look ahead, our goal is to remain cash-flow-positive throughout 2025 as we continue with our planned investments. Our priority continues to be ensuring The Kabbalah Centre can fulfill its mission of spreading the wisdom of Kabbalah to all who desire to learn around the world.
