KCI'S RESPONSE TO COVID-19

EXPAND ACCESS TO REACH MORE PEOPLE

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, we quickly pivoted our strategy by removing financial barriers and increasing the ways new and long-time students access Kabbalah. Thanks to an investment in our technological infrastructure in 2019, we had many of the tools to quickly transition to an online learning and working environment. We switched our foundational courses, High Holiday events, and other connections to a pay-what-you-can model, helping those experiencing financial difficulties stay connected to the Centre. We launched the Spiritually Hungry podcast to great aplomb, with over 300K views in 2020. We published Monica Berg's Rethink Love, which attracted new students by offering spiritual relationship guidance. And in spite of world events and a new online learning environment, our Global Kabbalah 1s saw a 50% increase in average student registration compared to Kabbalah 1 courses last year.

PROVIDE MORE AND IMPROVED RESOURCES

Bringing all of our presence online and into a centralized global calendar meant that we could enhance our content and better feature our diverse group of teachers to our growing community. Our team worked hard to expand our live stream schedule, implement a multilingual website, offer connections with live Spanish dubbing, and promote our variety of personalized teacher services. Whether through global healing calls, tzadikim tours, astrology panels, astrology charts, or personal meditations, our teachers and students got to know each other in new and profound ways.

A UNIFIED IMPACT

We all know and have felt the power of being surrounded by a group of like-minded friends and community. While 2020 physically separated us, virtually and spiritually, we were connected in groups larger than ever before. As seen through our Pesach and Rosh Hashanah live streams, the largest Zohar Project to date, and participation in our fundraising events throughout the year, our community was strong and made a collective difference in the world. Last year's Pesach livestreams hosted 14,000 students, and Rosh Hashanah welcomed 5,700 households—nearly double the attendance from 2019.







SPIRITUALLY HUNGRY

Michael and Monica Berg launched their official weekly podcast, Spiritually Hungry, in June of 2020, where their first 27 episodes of 2020 reached over 407,000 people. They dive deeply into spiritual topics like grief, forgiveness, love, anger, and much more.



OUR TEAM

The Kabbalah Centre counts on 99 teachers and 216 staff members committed to our mission. Our teachers continued to offer free one-on-one support to our students, teaching classes, and supporting the demands of our growing online community. We also launched a new way for students to connect with our talented teachers—Personal Guidance Sessions. Through our Guidance Sessions, students can receive one-on-one instruction with teachers including personal guided meditations, deep kabbalistic study, natal chart readings, spiritual executive coaching, and much more.





GUIDANCE SESSIONS

This year, we expanded our Personalized Guidance Sessions, a diverse series of customized one-on-one studies and meditations with our teachers. From relationship support with Monica Berg to a personalized 72 Names of God reading to deep dives into a specific area of study, students have the opportunity to focus on their individual needs and direct their energy into a topic or aspect of life of their preference. We have had great success with our Guidance Sessions so far, and have plans to expand the sessions to more areas of study in 2021 and beyond.

FINANCIALS

Dear Students, Community Members, and Supporters,

The year 2020 brought our organization, as with all businesses, families and governments around the world, unforeseen and monumental challenges as we all navigated the COVID-19 pandemic. For our Kabbalah Centre community and the Berg family, we also grappled with the passing of Karen Berg. Just as the Kabbalistic teachings share, we know nothing is inherently negative and every challenge brings opportunities for growth and positive transformation. As quarantines and social distancing transitioned all of us to rely on digital platforms like never before, The Kabbalah Centre too began a holistic and organization-wide transition to become centralized and digitally-focused. As the economic impact of the pandemic continued to spread, the Centre expanded its scholarship program and pivoted most offerings to a Pay What You Can model to continue to allow for the widest dissemination of the wisdom, especially in such dire times when the world and humanity can most benefit from Kabbalah's teachings. Through these necessary evolutions, we have been able to set the organization up for stability and growth in the years to come.

Through the finance, leadership and management teams' steadfast hard work, determination and great care over these past twelve tumultuous months, The Kabbalah Centre has continued the incredible financial transformation from 2019 that has allowed us to reach and achieve financial stability. This transformation is a direct result of the hard work to manage and significantly reduce the Centre's operating expenses, headcount, physical spaces, and contractual obligations. Equally as important to our growth, the Centre has continued to proactively invest in our digital platform, which has allowed us to generate enormous sustainable growth through online classes and events. Together, through the generation of mixed revenue sources and with reduced expenses, we have been able to realize results in 2020 that have yielded a solid operating surplus for the Centre.

Accountability:

For the third consecutive year, we engaged an independent audit firm, SAX LLP, in 2018, 2019 and again in 2020, to conduct a thorough review

of the Centre's financial statements. All of this was pursued with our goal and commitment to you of fostering a culture of transparency, accountability, and stewardship for the financial support and donations you entrust us with. Throughout this process, we have held ourselves to higher standards of financial reporting and review than those required of a non-profit 501(c)(3) religious sub-class designated organization, which is The Kabbalah Centre's filing status under the U.S. IRS tax code, which are not required uder law to file annual financial updates.

It is with great privilege and pleasure that we hereby report that the independent outside audit firm issued a clean opinion of the Centre's financial statements for the year ended December 31, 2020. The bottom-line results reflect a near breakeven from an operations perspective and a moderate surplus due to some extraordinary non-recurring activities. We were able to achieve such results while furthering our efforts to invest in our technological infrastructure and moving from a predominantly physical presence to a more streamlined, cohesive and cost-efficient digital presence. This digital presence has allowed the Centre to have a vast global outreach to the current community and new students through a robust calendar of online classes, publications and events.

Stewardship:

Our concerted internal efforts over the past year have also yielded many improvements, both toward our collective growth goals as well as our goal to continually improve our stewardship of resources. Below is an overview of the results of those efforts:

Expense Reduction: From our 2017 peak of \$60 million, we've reduced our overall annual expenses to ~\$25.7 million as of December 31, 2020, a 60% reduction in total expenses.

These reductions were mainly accomplished through:

• Organizational staff reductions by over 50% at both the global and local Centre levels

- Centralization of financial/operational functions and implementing a cost-sharing model with our local Centre's
- Reduction of all costs by maximizing our efforts, streamlining processes and vendor negotiations

Pay What You Can (PWYC):

The Pay What You Can model allows members, the community and students – both new and existing – to contribute what they can for online classes, courses and events. Throughout the 8 months of its existence in 2020, the PWYC model generated approximately \$700K in revenue. This model proves to be vital in sharing the teachings and resources of the Centre to our worldwide community and reaching all those with a desire to learn, regardless of their financial means. During the pandemic, this model enabled the Centre to sustain our operating revenue. To date in 2021, the PWYC model is well on its way to surpassing the 2020 total.

Technology: KCI significantly reduced its day-to-day operating IT expenses through contract negotiations and reduction of services resulting in annualized savings of ~\$2M, while maintaining our focus on growing the Centre's online presence and moving forward with the Pay What You Can (PWYC) model. We continue to learn from our experiences and we are prepared to make a sizable capital investment in our overarching technological infrastructure in 2021 and 2022.

KCI continues to achieve the goals that were set forth at the beginning of 2021 and continues to operate on a breakeven basis.

Stability & Growth:

As we look ahead to 2022 and the Centre's 100 year anniversary, we are committed to continuing our efforts of financial accountability and stewardship while looking ahead to invest in our talent and technological infrastructure to enable stability and growth for many years to come. In our pursuit of growth, we're focused on five categories:

- 1. Enhancing technology for benefit/use by students and the community
- 2. Reaching new students
- 3. Spreading The Zohar
- 4. Educating and supporting kids and teens
- 5. Expanded worldwide publishing activities

Underpinning these five categories of growth is the Centre's digital presence and platforms. We'll continue to invest in it with cutting edge technology and we're prepared to make a sizable capital investment in our overarching technological infrastructure in 2021 and 2022.

Amidst all of these concerted positive efforts, there are still obstacles and challenges facing the financial health of The Kabbalah Centre. As a non-profit organization dedicated to altruistic goals of spreading spiritual teachings and, through them, improving our students' lives, we endeavor to make the teachings and services we offer as affordable as possible for anyone to be able to access them. In addition, much like higher educational institutions, we rely on a robust cast of talented teachers and Chevre and their dedication, passion, and knowledge to disseminate this wisdom and nurture the spiritual journeys of our students. This large, global staff base carries an associated cost, one in which are committed to continuing to invest in by offering competitive wages and benefit packages.

As we look ahead, our goal is again to be cash-flow positive throughout 2021. We are on track to meet this goal, based on current financial projections and further expense reduction exploration. Our priority amidst all cost-cutting measures is to ensure The Kabbalah Centre continues to fulfill our mission of spreading the wisdom of Kabbalah to all who desire to learn around the world, with as minimal impact to the offerings, services, and experience of our student base. The Kabbalah Centre has gone through many iterations and evolutions throughout its history, and our operational and financial commitment to you is to ensure the organization is on solid and stable ground to enable a foundation that can allow it to evolve and grow in the decades to come, and beyond.
